

How H.E.R.O. Works




Part 1

School staff engage in a 2-hour professional development course



Part 2

Educators present the H.E.R.O. curriculum to students via four lesson plans, lasting approximately 30 - 45 minutes each



Part 3

The entire school or site participates in a set of safe, scripted drills
